

- Roots – anchor the plant in the ground; absorb water and nutrients from the soil
- Stem – supports the plant and contains food storage sites
- Petals – the colorful, leaflike structures that encircle the center part of the flower
- Leaves – site of photosynthesis, respiration, and transpiration
- Sepals – modified leaves that surround the flower as it develops
- Stamen – the male structure of the flower, containing the anther
- Anther – the structure that produces pollen
- Pistil – the female structure of the flower
- Ovary – the structure that contains the flower's eggs and is located on the bottom of the pistil
