Skin



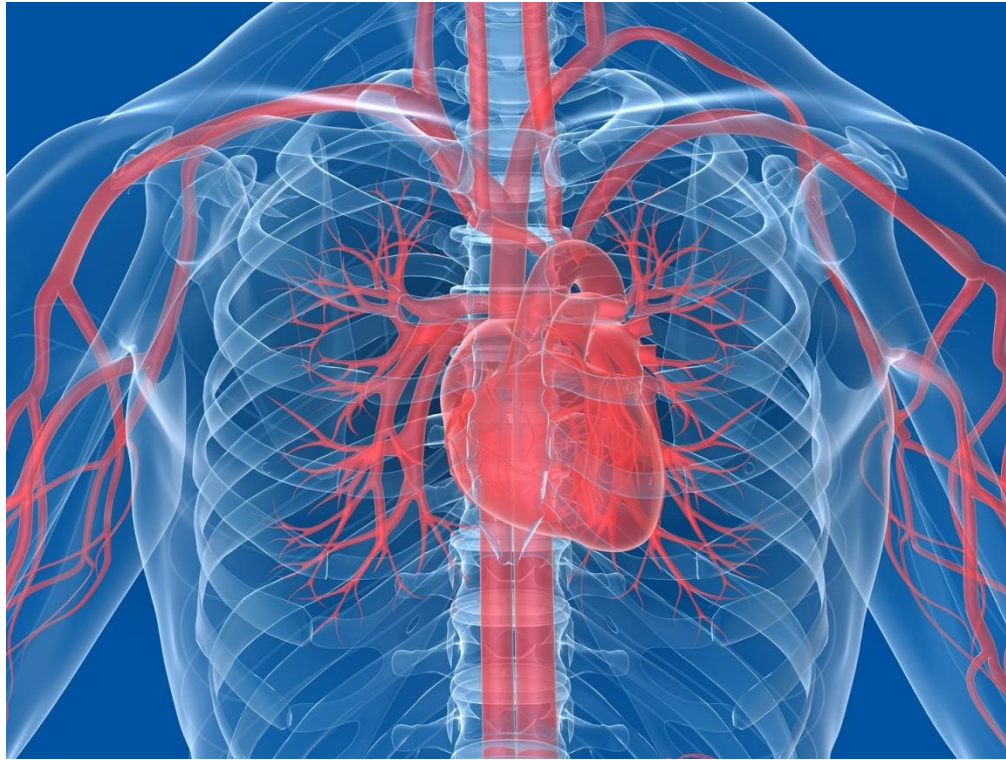
The outside layer of the body

Brain



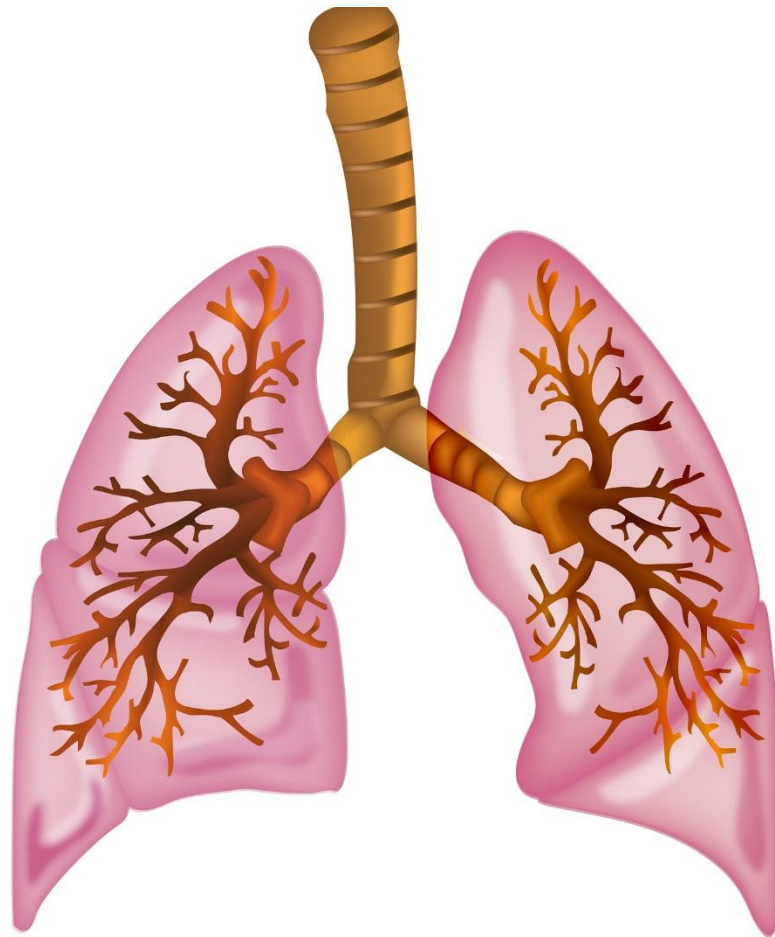
Receives and sends messages throughout the body in order to tell body parts what to do

Heart



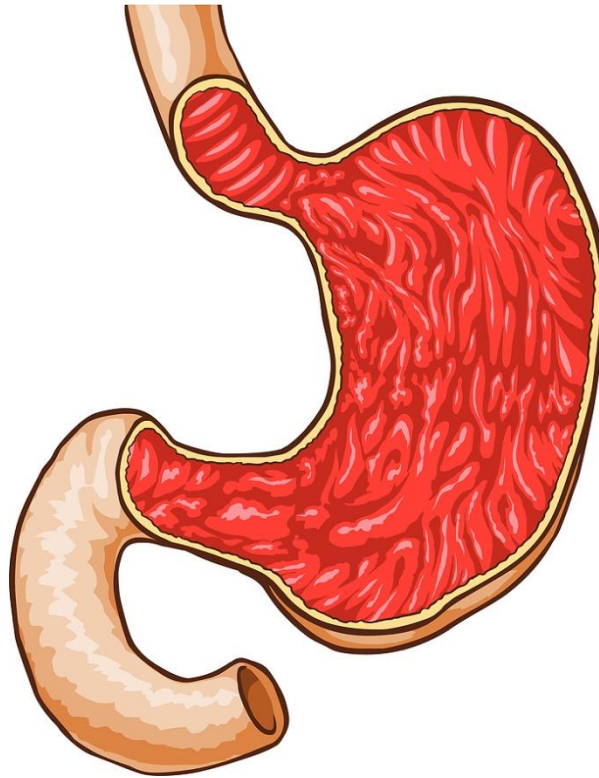
**Pumps blood enriched with nutrients to

Lungs



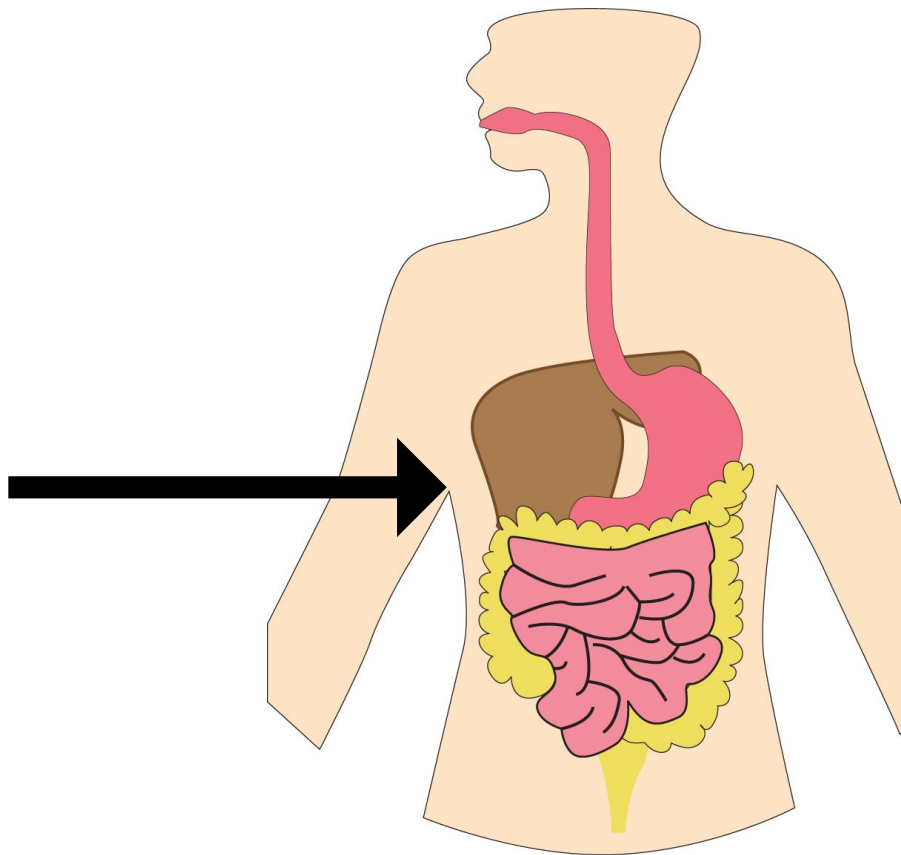
Allows air in and out of the body

Stomach



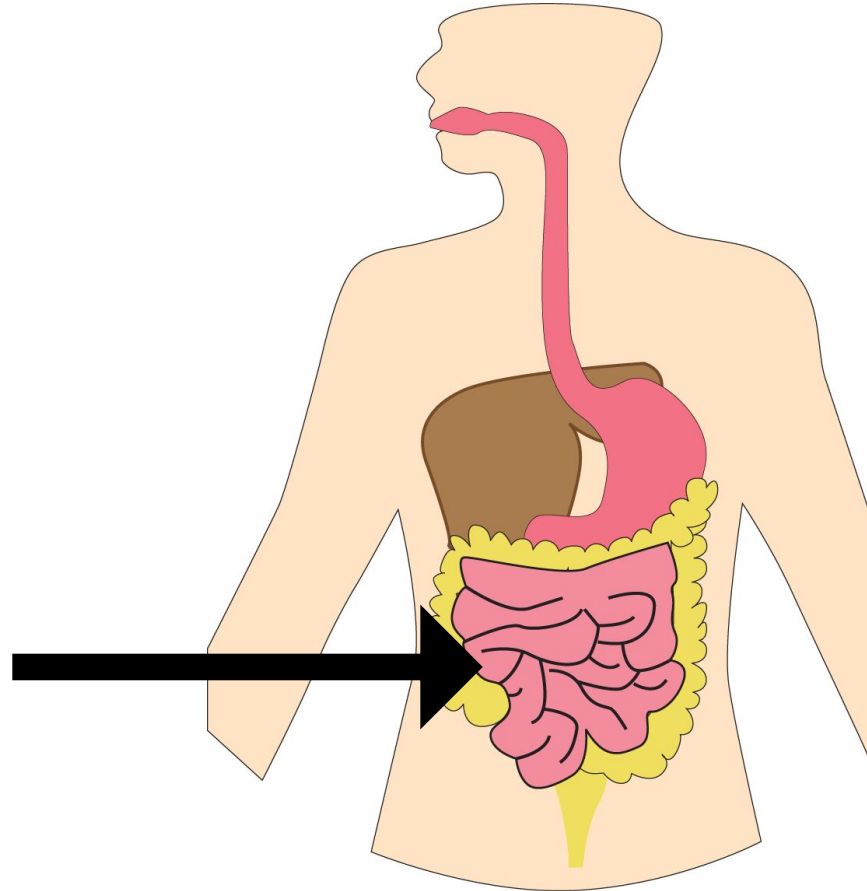
Breaks down food that supplies energy to the body

Liver



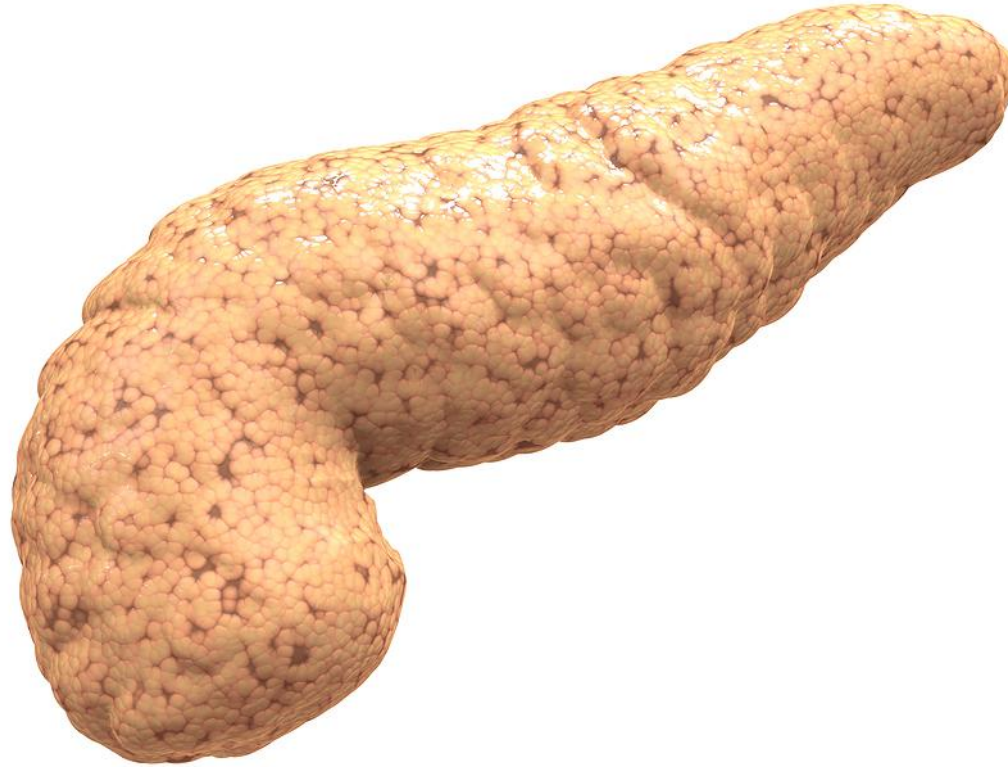
Organ that secretes bile to aid in digestion

Muscles



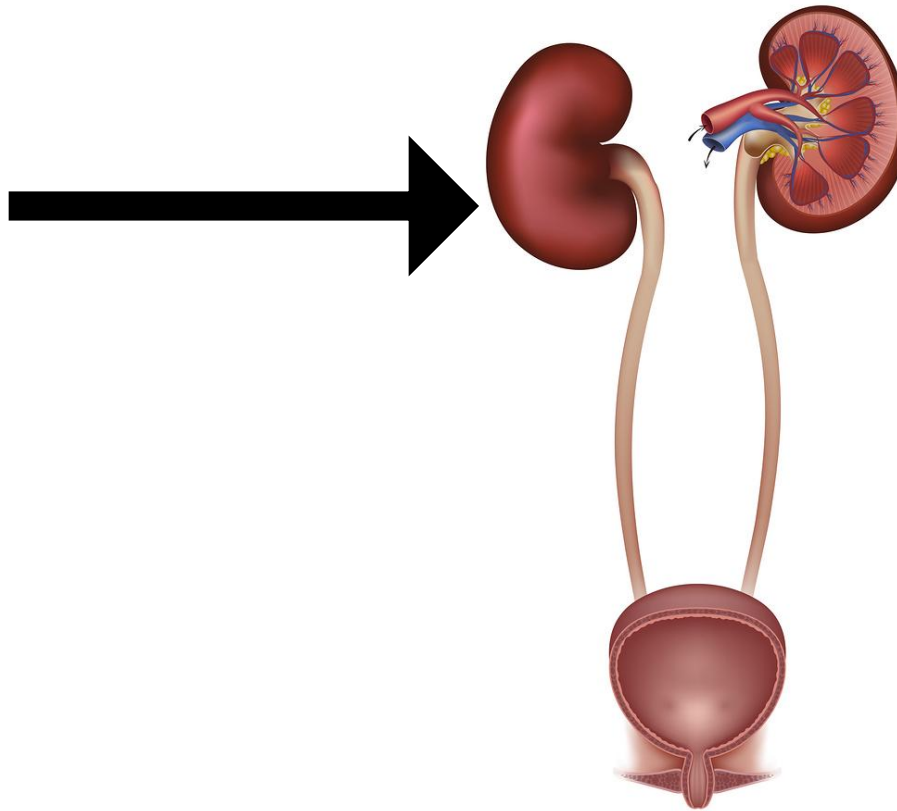
Structures inside your body that allow your body to move

Skeleton



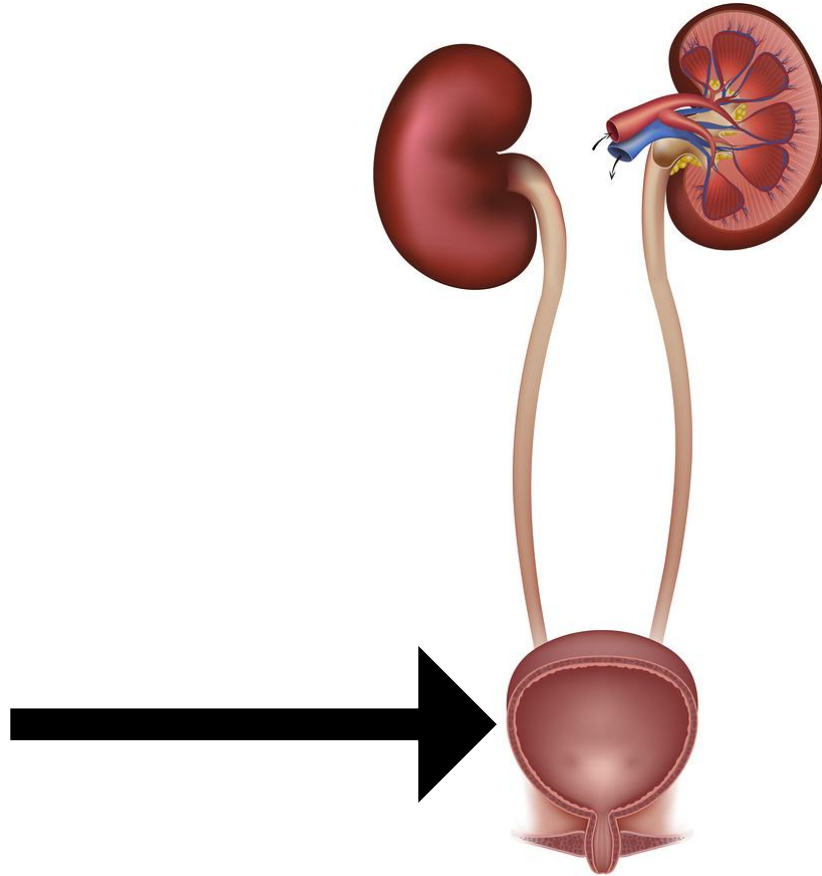
Made of bones internal structure that holds the body together

Kidney



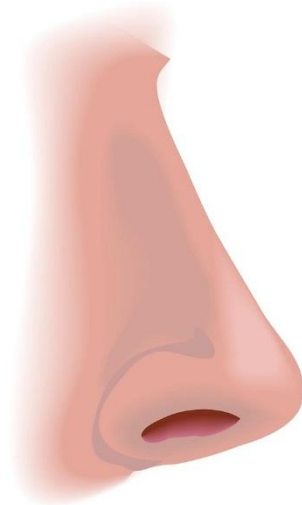
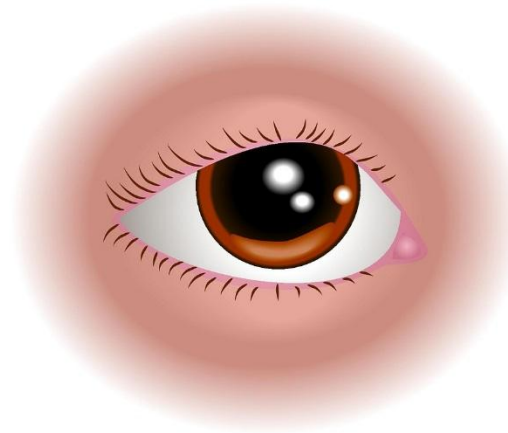
Organ that helps body maintain balance

Bladder



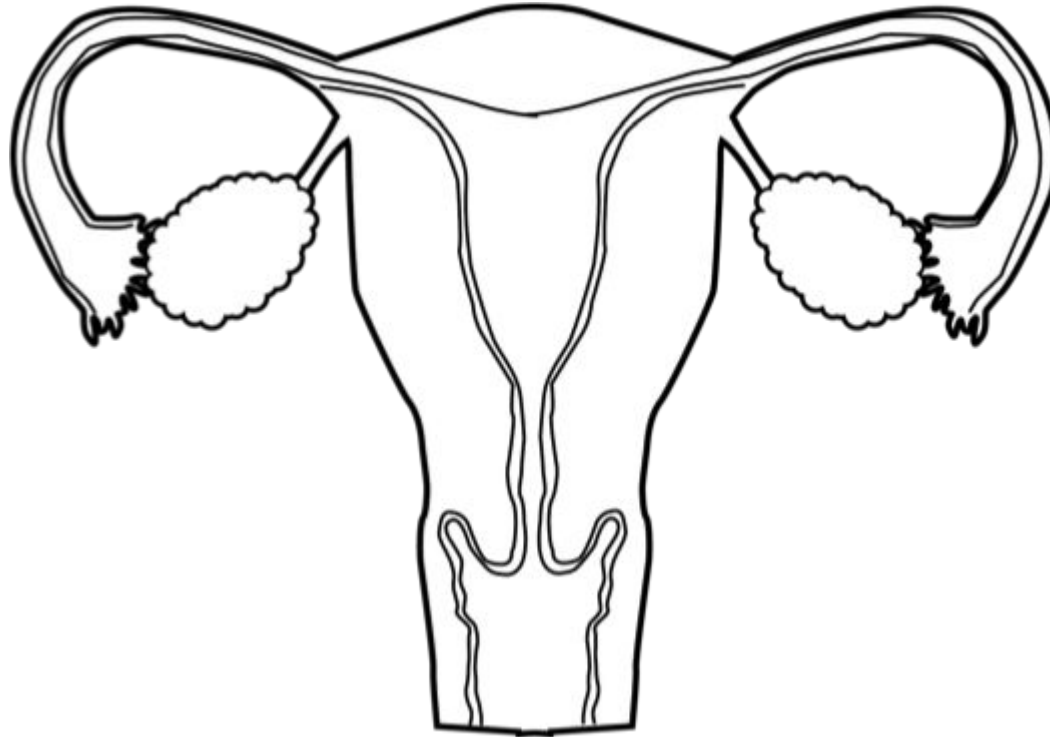
Organ that collects and holds urine
